### **PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES & RULES:**

1. **BOUNDARIES:** Within a 10 mile radius of the Granary Rural Cultural Center located at: **(40161 128th St., Groton, SD)**. Welcoming farm sites will be marked with a "Plein Air" yard sign. Please be respectful of landowners.
2. **FEES:** There will be a \$25 fee per artist to participate. College students - \$15 with a current student I.D. Cash, credit card and check accepted. Make checks payable to DPM.
3. **DURATION:** Artists can set up their equipment (after check-in) beginning at **8:00am on Thursday, September 21** and all paintings must be finished and at the Granary Gallery by **noon on Saturday, September 23** for the Wet Paint Sale. Please see "Schedule" for complete timeline of event happenings.
4. **BEGIN:** Artists must have all materials stamped before beginning to paint to assure the artwork is fast and fresh and created during the official time frame. Stamping at Dacotah Prairie Museum **(21 South Main St., Aberdeen, SD)** starting at 8:00am Thursday, September 21. For artists arriving Friday, September 22, stamping will be at the Granary Gallery beginning at 8:00am. All canvases must be stamped prior to painting.
5. **FRAMING:** Framing will be at the discretion and expense of each painter.
6. **PRIZES:** There will be an Artist's Choice and a People's Choice with a cash award.
7. **SALES:** Artists are fully responsible for selling their own work directly and collecting sales tax; there will be no commission charged by the Granary Rural Cultural Center or Dacotah Prairie Museum.

**ROOM BLOCK:** A limited block of rooms is available at the AmericInn Lodge in Aberdeen at **State Rate (\$55)** to participants. Please call the hotel at 605.225.4565 and ask for "Granary Plein Air" room block.

**Rooms must be reserved by August 21, 2017.**
