She started doing art at age 6 and later studied at Art School in Iowa where she became a painter, sculptor, printmaker and collage' artist. She was a leader in the Decorative/Patterned Art Movement. Her figures were always dancing, moving and gesturing. Her artworks are alive with color, pattern & excitement!

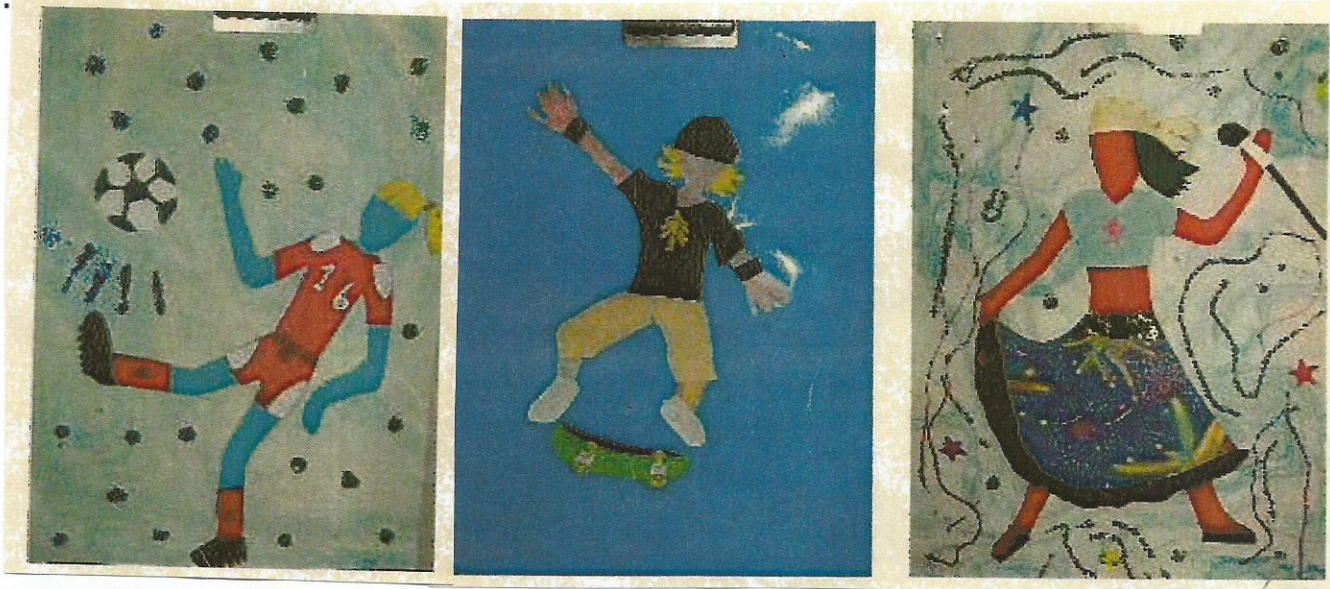
In This Package You Will Find:

You Will Need:

- Scissors
- White glue or Glue stick
- Pencil
- Watercolor or Acrylic paint
- Bowl of Water
- Larger paintbrush

What To Do to Create Your Collage':

- 1) Paint your background sheet (card shock) completely. You may mix colors or choose your favorite - let dry.
- 2) On practice paper draw yourself in one of your favorite activities, drawing large. Use this as a guideline for the finished figure.
- 3) Plan figure from assorted papers –mix solids with patterns.
- 4) Glue pieces figure in place on dry, painted back ground!
- 5) A great collage'!
